



Year 1 – 6 Remote Learning on Teams 2021

Outline guide for a day - Parents

Children need to be logged onto the class Teams Call between

- **9:15am and 10:30am**
- **11:00am and 12:00**
- **2:30 – 3:00pm.**

During these times the teachers and TAs will be working virtually with the children. They will ask the children to stay on the Teams call whilst completing their work so if they have any questions they can ask them straight away just like they would in the classroom.

9:15am – 9:30am: Registration and outline of learning for the day

The teacher will provide a morning task / question for the children to complete while everyone is logging on. E.g. handwriting, spellings or Maths questions. Please ensure your child has a piece of paper and pen.

9:30am – 10:30am: English / Reading Session

The children will have a live English lesson with their teacher. They will need to have paper, pencil and a different coloured pen.

10:30am – 11:00am: Break time

Children will have half an hour to have a drink and snack. They need to be back online at 11am.

11:00am – 11:50am: Maths

The children will have a live Maths lesson with their teacher. They will need to have paper, pencil and a different coloured pen.

11:50am – 12:00pm: Morning Round-Up/Afternoon expectations

The teachers will show the children where to access the work for the afternoon on Teams / Oak National Academy.

12:00pm – 1:00pm – Lunchtime

1:00pm – 2:30pm: Independent work at home using the learning grids in Teams

Children to complete online work Science and Foundation Subjects work as directed by the class teacher.

2:30pm – 3:00pm: Afternoon Round-Up/Story

On teams the children will talk about today's learning and listen to some of their class book.

Helpful Tips

Please make sure that when you join a Teams lesson:

1. You are muted and only unmute when your teacher asks.
2. You turn your video on so your teacher can see you working hard.
3. You have paper, pencil and a coloured pen ready.
4. If you have a question you put your virtual hand up.
5. Please DO NOT use the chat section in the lesson to message friends. You need to be listening to your teachers.
