Attendance

We were thrilled with our final attendance figures last year and are keen to build on that this year. We were above national average across the board and had also seen improvements on our figures from 2017-2018. This year we will be rewarding 100% attendance on a term by term basis, with children who have achieved this receiving a small reward at the beginning of the following term. If a child has had time off for whatever reason, this will still obviously be included in their reportable absence figure, but will not stop them from achieving the 100% during following terms and therefore receiving the reward. We will also celebrate the class with the best attendance each week in celebration assembly.

Our Pastoral team will continue to apply our Pupil Attendance Policy (available on our school website) and letters will be sent to inform you if your child's attendance has dropped below 96% - we appreciate that children get ill and clearly don't want you to send them in if they are poorly, however it is still important that we make you aware of the impact of this on their attendance figure.
