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NPAT Curriculum

Our teaching staff attended the launch of our brand new NPAT curriculum on Wednesday evening, which has been developed following a huge amount of research and hard work from groups of staff from across the Trust. After half term, Years 1-6 will begin teaching the new units of work for Geography, R.E. and Science. The new curriculum has a clear focus on the acquisition of knowledge content and has been constructed as a meaningful journey over time with clearly planned vertical, horizontal and diagonal links. The teams working on its development have undertaken extensive research about Cognitive Science and how we learn and there will be high quality training opportunities for teachers to develop their appropriate subject knowledge before delivering the lessons to the children. This forms a crucial part of our school focus on providing the best quality education we can for our children and all staff are very excited to start work on this in Term 2. For you as parents, you can expect to receive 'Knowledge Organisers' for Geography (or History depending what term we are in as they alternate), R.E. and Science before the holidays so that you can see what your children will be learning in the following term – these will replace our existing 'Curriculum News' bulletins. They will also be available on the school website each term. In-line with our new homework policy, you may want to consider any work or trips you want to do with your children prior to them starting the unit although this is not compulsory.

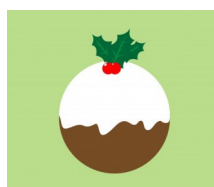
