Homework



We are concerned that we are seeing an increasing lack of engagement with homework across the school and would urge you to

ensure your children are completing their home learning tasks and submitting them on time. Teachers will endeavour to mark homework promptly each week, and before the next task is set. We have worked hard over the last two years to adapt our policy so that it is clear, realistic and focusses on the things that we know really make a difference when supported at home. The table below sums up our expectations – if you have any questions about this, then please speak with your child's teacher in the first instance. The full policy is available on our website.



All children should read a minimum of three times per week and this should be recorded in their Reading Record. In YR-4 this should be completed by a parent. Y5/6 can complete independently.
