Please be aware that we have a training day on **Monday 4th November**. Our term dates for this year and next year are available on the school website or from the office for your reference.

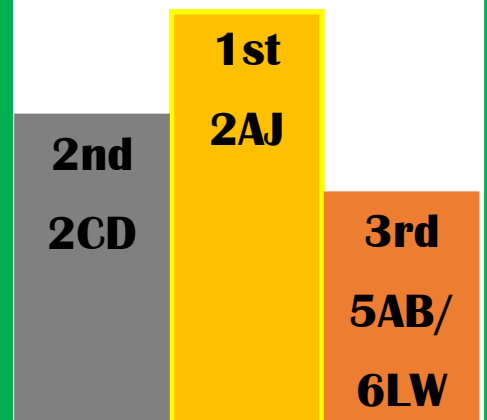


Rainbow Star of the Week
