School Christmas Lunch will be on Wednesday 18th December. Please book via Schoolgrid.

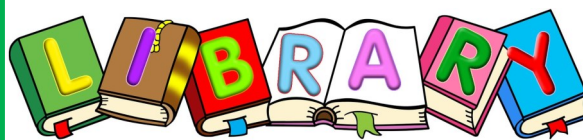


P.E News

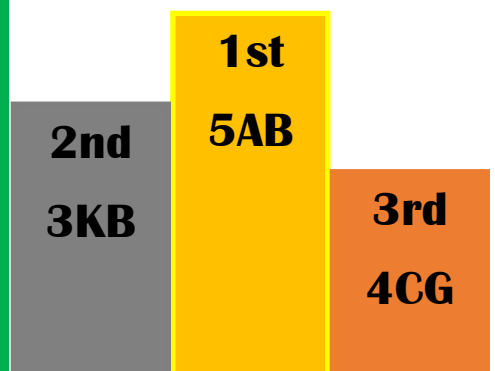
